The petitioner has preferred this petition for issuance of directions to respondents to release/disburse the payment related to Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for Scheduled Caste students.

In this connection, the petitioner-Society has made many representations.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the representation. He, however, states that the petitioners have not even received their full reimbursement pertaining to the years 2014-15 and 2015-16 and nothing has been paid regarding 2016-17 and due to this the petitioner-Council is in dire financial states. He further argues that pursuant to the previous Civil Writ petition No.10519 of 2014 which the petitioner had filed for release of earlier dues, this Court had directed the respondents to decide the representation and pursuant thereto some money was released to the petitioner-Council.

In these circumstances, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-5). In case, the petitioner is entitled to relief claimed, grant the same to it. The necessary exercise be conducted within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
