Applicant Meena has moved this bail application seeking regular bail in connection with Crime No.66 of 2017 under sections 380, 411 and 34 I.P.C., registered on the basis of first information report dated 09.05.2017, Police Station Clementown, District Dehradun.

It is stated that though alleged recovery was shown to be recovered from the applicant but the same is false and concocted story made by the complainant in collusion with police due to hot talk with other ladies. It is stated that applicant is a 48 years old house wife and is having a child of one and half years. It is stated that applicant is a woman and is entitled for the benefits of proviso to Section 437 of Cr.P.C. Coaccused have been granted bail. It is further stated that if she is granted bail, she will not misuse the same.

Having considered submissions of learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion as to final merits of the case, this Court is of the view that applicant deserves bail.

Accordingly, the bail application is allowed. Let applicant Smt. Meena be released on bail on executing personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned.
