By means of present contempt petition, the petitioner prayed for compliance of order dated 02.5.2017 passed in WPSS No.793/2017, "Rajendra Prasad Pandey vs. State of Uttrakhand & others".

Order sought to be executed is as follows:-

"Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization as per notification dated 30.12.2013 within a period of eight weeks from today."

Compliance affidavit is taken on record.

Delay in filing the same is condoned.

Delay condonation application (CLMA No.15568/2017) thus stands disposed of.

Since order sought to be executed has been complied with, therefore, this Court is not inclined to keep contempt petition pending. Contempt petition is, accordingly, closed.

Learned counsel, thereafter, submitted that petitioner will file a separate writ petition. This Court is not required to give liberty to the petitioner to enforce a right, which is available to him in law.
