By means of present writ petition, the petitioner seeks following relief, among others:

“Issue a writ, order or direction of mandamus directing the respondents to pay entire arrear of revised pension and other benefits to the petitioner since 01.01.2006 to 15.01.2015 with interest in accordance with 6th Pay Commission and further direct the respondents to give the benefit of 7th Pay Commission to the petitioner.”

After arguing the writ petition at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent that respondent no. 2 may kindly be directed to decide petitioner's representation, to which, learned counsel for the respondents have no objection.

Present writ petition is *disposed of* by directing respondent no. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing a reasoned and speaking order, at an earliest possible but not later than **three weeks** of presentation of certified copy of this Order alongwith a fresh representation.

Needless to say that decision so taken shall be communicated to the petitioner soon thereafter.

Let a copy of this order be supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner today itself on payment of usual charges.
