Petitioner is facing trial in respect of offences punishable under Section 2/3 of Gangster Act, in S.T. no. 29 of 2010, State vs Azeem Ahmad and others.

After arguing the petition, preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner confined her prayer only to the extent that some time be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the court concerned and non-bailable warrant as well as processes under Sections 82 and 83 Cr.P.C. issued against the petitioner be kept in abeyance in the meanwhile. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that the petitioner is ready to furnish fresh bail bonds.

Considering the facts of the case, petitioner is granted three weeks' time from today to surrender before the court concerned, where after he will be dealt with by the court having jurisdiction, in accordance with law. Non-bailable warrant as well as processes under Section 82 and 83 Cr.P.C. issued against the petitioner shall be kept in abeyance during the aforesaid period.

It is further provided that if the petitioner surrenders before the court concerned within the stipulated time and seeks bail, his bail application shall be decided as expeditiously as possible, without unreasonable delay, in accordance with law.

Present C-482 petition thus stands disposed of.
