By means of present writ petition, the petitioner seeks following relief:-

Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent nos.1 to 3 to follow the reservation policy and induct the name of the petitioner in the final selection list as Physical Education Assistant Teacher (L.T.).

After arguing the writ petition at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent that the representation of the petitioner may kindly be directed to be decided by respondent no.2, to which learned Deputy Advocate General has no objection.

Writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent no.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner by a reasoned and speaking order, as early as possible, but not later than four weeks of presentation of certified copy of this order along with a copy of representation before said respondent, in accordance with law.

Needless to say that the decision so taken shall be communicated to the petitioner soon thereafter.
