The applicant is in jail having been implicated in Range Case No.18/Tanda/2017-18, which has been registered under Sections 26 (1) (f) (g) of the Indian Forest Act, at Tanda Range, Tanda Central Forest Division, Haldwani, District Nainital.

Learned Senior Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is in jail since 23.08.2017.

Considering the overall evidence which is presently available before this Court, and the fact that the applicant is in jail since 23.08.2017, *prima facie*, the applicant has been able to make out a case for bail. The bail application is allowed accordingly.

Let the applicant be enlarged on bail in the aforesaid crime on his executing a personal bond and two reliable sureties each of the equal amount to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned/court concerned.

It is made clear that any observations made by this Court are only for the purposes of grant of bail. It shall not be taken into consideration at all in any other proceedings.
