This is the first bail application moved by the applicant.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and considered the grounds taken up in the bail application.

Applicant Ankit Garg has moved this bail application seeking regular bail in connection with Case Crime No./F.I.R No. 220 of 2017 under sections 420, 406 and 120-B of I.P.C., Police Station Kotwali, District Dehradun.

An FIR has been lodged against the applicant alleging therein that applicant along with other co-accused have embezzled crores of rupees of the complainant and other persons on the pretext of committee.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is ready for settlement with the affected persons. He submits that he will try to settle the dispute between the parties and will make payment of the amount which is to be paid by him to the complainant. He further submits that if bail is granted to him, he will not misuse the same.

Having considered submissions of learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion as to final merits of the case, this Court is of

the view that applicant deserves bail at this stage.

Accordingly, the bail application is allowed. Let applicant be released on bail on executing personal bond and furnishing two reliable and local sureties, each of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned.
