An FIR has been lodged against the petitioner being Case Crime No. 157 of 2017, for the offences punishable under Sections 420,467,468,471 IPC, at Police Station Rudrapur, District Udham Singh Nagar.

After arguing the writ petition at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent that some time may be given to the petitioner to surrender before the Magistrate concerned and, thereafter, court below be directed to decide the bail application of the petitioner at an early date.

Considering the facts of the case, <u>Four weeks</u> time is granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Court concerned. No coercive measures shall be taken against the petitioner for a period of four weeks from today.

If the petitioner surrenders before the Court concerned well within time and seeks bail, it is provided that his bail application shall be decided as expeditiously as possible without unreasonable delay.

Writ petition stands disposed of with the direction, as above.
