1. Having considered the reasons for rejecting application submitted by the petitioner for grant of first parole, we are of the opinion that the reasons do not stand scrutiny of the law.

2. That the family of the deceased whom the petitioner allegedly murdered reside in the same village and there is possibility of breach of peace in the village is no reason to deny parole for the simple reason that in rural areas crimes of murder

are committed where the offender and the victim reside in the same village. If this be the reason to deny parole, no convict in such kinds of cases would be granted parole. As regards the other reason, of the petitioner being an accused in few other cases, we find that all cases are old.

3. The petition is disposed of directing that upon the petitioner furnishing a personal bond in sum of ₹25,000/- with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Superintendent, Central Jail, Bharatpur, he would be released on parole for a period of 20 days. The petitioner would report his attendance at the police station in which his residence falls on every Monday falling in the period of parole.
