1. Called in revise. None appeared to press this writ petition. In the circumstances, I myself have perused the record.

2. By means of present writ petition, petitioner has sought following reliefs:

“i) to issue a writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to pay arrear of salary of the petitioner of seven months (Rupees 7275/-) with interest from 1991.

ii) to issue a writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make the payment of arrear of salary with interest without any further delay.”

3. I myself have gone through pleadings, grounds as also reliefs sought and find that petitioner is not able to make out a case so as to justify interference of this Court by granting reliefs, as prayed for.

4. Moreover, it appears that either cause of action no more survives or the petitioner has lost interest in the matter or it has otherwise become infructuous and, probably for this reason, none is interested to have decided this matter on merits and that is why, counsel for petitioner is absent.

5. Dismissed. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
