**ORAL ORDER**

2 31-05-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned APP for the State.

The petitioners seek regular bail in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) PS case no. 282 of 2018 instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of Bihar Excise (Amendment) Act, 2016.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 450 ltrs. of illicit liquor from a Safari vehicle.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that neither the petitioners are the owner of the said vehicle nor the recovery has been made from the conscious possession of the petitioners. It is further submitted that the petitioners are having



clean antecedents and they are languishing in custody since 25.04.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the abovenamed petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise (Gaya) in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) PS case no. 282 of 2018.
