A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioners, already in custody, seek bail in connection  
with warisnagar (Mathurapur O.P.) Case No. 243 of 2017,  
registered under Sections 419, 467, 468, 471, 120B of the Indian  
Penal Code and 3/10 of B.C.E.Act, 1981.

The allegation is that the petitioners were  
impersonating the real candidate in the written examination for  
appointment to the post of Constables.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioners are students and he is in custody since 23.10.2017 and  
charge sheet has already been submitted against the petitioners.



Having considered the said facts and circumstances, the petitioners, Gulson Kumar @ Gulshan Kumar and Rahul Kumar are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- ( Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Warisnagar (Mathurapur O.P.) P. S. Case No. 243 of 2017.
