2 29-06-2018 Heard Sri Abhishek Kumar, learned counsel for the
petitioner and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, having clean antecedent, which fact has been stated in paragraph-3 of the petition, apprehending his arrest in Kotwa P.S. Case No.249 of 2017 registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 35(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, has prayed for grant of bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender, primarily on the ground of parity.

It has been argued that the accused person, against whom there was serious allegation than the petitioner, has already been granted anticipatory bail vide Cr.Misc.No.24316 of 2018 by order dated 25.04.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that one another accused, namely,



Mithilesh Singh, in similar circumstances, has been granted anticipatory bail by a Bench of this Court.

Considering the fact that at least two other co-accused, in similar circumstances, have been extended the privilege of anticipatory bail, there is no reason to pass a different order in the present case.

Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, namely, Ankit Kumar @ Nanhaki be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 4th Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Kotwa P.S. Case No.249 of 2017, subject to conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
