ORDER

Seen the compliance Report dated 20.08.2018 of the State-  
Respondents.

It is submitted therein that on the basis of the inspection dated  
14.08.2018, conducted by the Officers of the Excise (Abkari)  
Department/Respondent No.2, and after duly comparing the proposed  
rough sketch map of the Petitioners, they are ready to grant Foreign  
Liquor Retail licences to the Petitioners No. 1 to 10 and 12, on the  
following conditions which are reproduced below;

*"(a) That the petitioners No 1 to 10 and 12 shall completely  
block the entry from the front facing the highway.*

*(b) They shall make the access for the entry from the side of  
the building which does not face the Highway. The main  
entry/door or the sale counter of FLR shop shall be from*

*the end corner of the side of the building not facing the road.*

*(c) That the Licenses and sign board shall not be displayed outside facing the road but shall displayed (sic) inside the shop.”*

For Condition at (b), it is clarified that the entry is from the side of the “shop” as reflected in the rough sketch map and not “building” as submitted in the compliance Report.

The Petitioners are agreeable to the conditions.  
In the circumstances, nothing survives for adjudication.  
Consequently, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
