Mr. RK Deepak, learned counsel appears for the petitioner and Mr. BR Sharma, learned counsel for the respondent No. 5.

Mr. A. Bimol, learned senior counsel appearing for the JNIMS submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as far as the relief claimed in Prayer No. 21(ii) is concerned. The aforesaid prayer reads as follows:

"Issue a writ of Certiorary, Mandamus and/or any other appropriate writ/order/direction to quash/set aside the Orders dated 11.07.2016 whereby Respondent No. 4 was appointed to the post of Director (i/c) for six months till 14.01.2017."

Mr. A. Bimol, learned senior counsel submits that another person has been appointed as a Director in place of the respondent No. 4.

In view of the above, this Court is of the view that nothing survives for consideration.

Mr. RK Deepak, learned counsel submits that as far as the Prayer No. 21(iv) is concerned, it still survives as an inquiry can be directed to be held regarding the teaching experience of the respondent No. 4. This Court is of the view that it may not be necessary at this stage to pass any order in this regard, unless he is appointed as a Director again and this issue may be raised again by the petitioner, if the respondent No. 4 is again appointed as a Director.

Petition stands closed with liberty to the petitioner to file the appropriate petition in terms of the above observation.
