ORDER

Heard Shri M. Hemchandra, learned Sr. counsel appearing for the petitioner.

The case of the petitioner is that she is the legal heir/ the wife of the deceased who was working as Lance Naik in Manipur Rifles and was enrolled on 15th August, 1974.After having considered the performance of the petitioner's husband, he was awarded cash awards.

Sometime in the year 1992, the petitioner's husband was seriously ill but he could not be taken outof the State for medical treatment due to financial constraints. In the meantime, the petitioner's husband was placed under suspension in contemplation of an inquiry for gravely misconduct and unauthorized absent with effect from 28.10.1992. While the petitioner's husband was in suspension, he had expired.

Accordingly, the petitioner submitted a written representation dated 19.11.1998 to the state respondent to revoke the suspension order and to issue a termination order in respect of her husband for payment of pension and pensionary benefits and the said representation is still pending for consideration.

Shri M. Hemchandra, learned Sr. counsel further submits that the instant writ petition can be disposed of by issuing ainnocuous order and accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of with the direction that the respondents and in particular, the DGP, Manipur shall consider the representation submitted by the petitioner within a period of 1(one) month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order by issuing a speaking order.
