Heard Mr. SB Debnath, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. A. Roy Barman, learned Additional PP appearing for the State-respondent.

The accused person Pinal Shil @ Pinal Kanti Shil was arrested on 13.07.2018 in connection with Manu Bazar PS case No. 47 of 2018 under sections 148/149/341/353/307/427/302 of the IPC and till today he is in custody.


Mr. Debnath, learned counsel appearing for the accused person submits that the accused person is totally innocent and he has no connection with the mob that attacked a person, who was subsequently found dead. Mr. Debnath, further submits that the accused person is a cultivator and daily bread earner having his family members and parents. Mr. Debnath, also submits that the accused person is in custody for 100 days and the charge sheet has already been filed.

Mr. Roy Barman, learned Additional PP appearing for the State-respondent submits that the accused person had murdered the person namely Sukanta Chakraborty brutally, and charge-sheet has already been filed against all the accused persons.

Considering the fact that the charge-sheet has already been submitted and there is no chance of absconsion of the accused person, this court is inclined to release the accused person on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- each supported by two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge, South Tripura, Belonia on condition that the accused person will appear before the Investigating Officer 4 days in a week as well as he will make himself available before the trial court every day.

Consequently, the bail application is allowed and thus disposed of.
