Heard learned Sr. counsel for the petitioner, Mr. G.Uzir assisted by Mr. M.Saikia. Also heard Mr. M.R.Islam learned counsel for the respondents No. 1-4 and Mr. P.Nongbri, learned counsel for the respondent No. 5.

The matter came up for hearing.

The dispute herein is that the petitioner as well as the respondent No. 5 has applied for the permit to run a petrol pump from the respondents No. 1-4 (Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited).

Learned Sr. counsel for the petitioner submits that inspite of giving the land she was not given the permit without giving any valid reason.

On the other hand, both the learned counsel for the respondents No. 1-4 and learned counsel for the respondent No. 5 submit that petitioner could not meet the norms to run the petrol pump as per the National Highway norms.

The submission of the respondents counsels was refuted by the petitioner counsel who submits that though initially there was shortage of 12

metres of land, but petitioner immediately offered an additional land of 12 metres to get the permit, but the same was not considered.

metres to get the permit, but the same was not considered.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent No. 5 submits

that he is already running the petrol pump.

In such circumstances, this Court directs the respondents to consider the

application filed by the petitioner, if any and give her the permit to run an

alternative petrol pump and should not reject her petition on mere technicality

or personal grudge.

Learned counsel for the respondents No. 1-4 also submits that they have

already advertised for new application and if the Court directs, then a

corrigendum may be issued adding the location which is NH 44E in West

Khasi Hills District.

Accordingly, respondents No. 1-4 are directed that if any application is

made by the petitioner, her application should be given priority and be

considered. It is also brought to my notice by Mr. T.T.Diengdoh, learned Sr.

counsel that Govt. of India is going to grant permit for another 225 petrol

pumps in the State of Meghalaya. In such circumstances, petitioner should be

accommodated in the NH 44E.

With this observation, this instant writ petition is allowed to that extent

and stands disposed of. This whole exercise is to be completed as early as

possible. In case any injustice is caused to the petitioner, petitioner will be at

liberty to approach the court once again for further direction.
