Oral:-

1. Admitted position as appear from the respective submissions of the learned counsel for the parties is that, the petitioner is working as a teacher in Singimari Girls School, West Garo Hills, the salary in his favour has been released and paid up to March 2018.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that his salary w.e.f. 01.04.2018 till date has not been released, as such is facing serious financial hardships.

3. According to learned GA, the respondents have released the salary up to August 2018, which was to be paid to the petitioner by the Managing Committee of the School, in support whereof he has produced Xerox copies of sanction orders, same be taken on records.

4. It is further submission of the learned GA that the release of salary beyond August 2018 is subject to availability of funds but assure that as soon as the funds are released by the Government of India, sanction order will be issued, for payment of the salary for period September 2018 onwards, to the Managing Committee for its payment to the teachers, which include petitioner.

5. In view of the stated position, nothing survives for determination in this petition. Suffice it to say that the Managing Committee of the School shall ensure payment of salary to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.04.2018 till ending August 2018 within ten days, thereafter on release of funds by the Central Government and sanction thereof by the respondents to pay the salary to the petitioner regularly after adherence to the rules.

6. Disposed of as above.
