This is an application, filed under Section 439 Cr.PC, praying for bail of the accused-petitioner, namely, Sajal Kumar Roy, in connection with Katigorah PS Case No. 62/2017 under Sections 365/435 IPC (corresponding to GR Case No. 506/2017)

Heard Mr. F.A. Laskar, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner as well as Mr. N.K. Kalita, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the state respondent.

I have perused the petition as well as the annexures furnished therewith.

The accused-petitioner is in custody for 49 days as on date. Considering the period of detention, further custodial detention of the accused-petitioner is not considered necessary, and therefore, his prayer for bail is allowed.

Accordingly, the accused-petitioner is granted bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. **20,000/-** with two suitable sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial

Magistrate, Cachar, Silchar, on the following conditions:

- (1) The accused-petitioner shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Cachar, Silchar, without prior written permission from the said learned court,
- (2) The accused-petitioner shall not hamper with the investigation, or tamper with the evidence of the case, and
- (3) The accused-petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
