Heard Mr. B. Chetri, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. S.S. Roy, learned Government Advocate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that this petition can be disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court on earlier occasion on 26.07.2018 in WP(C) No.1215/2018.

In this case, the petitioners have become over aged. Some of the claimants for appointment to the post of Veterinary Field Assistant who had also become age barred had approached this Court by filing writ petition mentioned above, which was allowed by the Court with a direction to the respondent authorities to consider the request for condoning the age bar. It has been submitted by Mr. B. Chetri, learned counsel for the petitioners that present three petitioners, however, could not approach this Court earlier and has prayed that they may be given the same benefit of consideration by the authorities for condoning the age bar.

Learned counsel for the State fairly submits that the State would have no objection to considering the case of the petitioners for condoning the age bar as have been done to other similarly situated persons referred in above.

Accordingly, present petition is disposed of with a similar direction to the respondents as issued in the earlier writ petition WP(C) No.1215/2018 for considering the case of the petitioners for condoning the age bar and allow them to take part in the recruitment process.

With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
