ORAL

1. Going by the nature of relief sought for and with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is **admitted** to hearing and the same is taken up for final disposal.

2. The petitioner, in the present writ petition, seeks the relief in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to recommend the name of the petitioner to the Government for appointment as Teacher in District Cadre, Jammu as she has been duly selected.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has applied for the post of Teacher in District Cadre, Jammu pursuant to Advertisement Notice No.05 of 2013 dated 02.03.2013 and Advertisement Notice No.06 of 2013 dated 10.05.2013. She claims to have passed 10+2 and thereafter graduation and she further claims to have been selected but no recommendation for her appointment is forthcoming.

4. Mr. Sharma, learned Dy.A.G. appearing for the respondents, states that there is some issues relating to the petitioner's Permanent Resident Certificate which will be considered by the authority in accordance with law as may be directed by this Court.

5. In this view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation to the respondents alongwith all requisite documents and if validly selected, the authority shall accord consideration to the claim of the petitioner on its own merits in accordance with law applicable and pass a speaking order expeditiously, preferably within a period of four to six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order alongwith representation.

6. The writ petition alongwith connected MP stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
