Heard learned counsel for the parties. Learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

The petitioners are accused for allegedly committing an offence punishable under Sections 356/382 IPC.

It is alleged that informant's bag was snatched by some unknown miscreants.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are in custody since 7.8.2017 and they are not put on TIP and charge-sheet has been submitted in this case.

Taking into consideration the period of custody and the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted in this case without conducting TIP, I am inclined to allow this application. Accordingly, the petitioners above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi in connection with Sadar Police Station Case No. 349 of 2017 (G.R. No. 3618 of 2017), subject to the condition that the petitioners should appear and mark their attendance before the Sadar police station in the district of Ranchi once in a month, failing which their bail bond shall stand cancelled and the officer-in-charge Sadar police station will take appropriate steps for their arrest.
