Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Petitioner is an accused for allegedly committing the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 342, 353, 332, 333, 337, 338, 188, 186, 283, 307, 158, 109 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with Panki Police Station Case No.28 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No.594 of 2014, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palamau at Daltonganj.

An accident had taken place, as a result of which, villagers and others blocked the road and also obstructed the police from performing their duties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no specific allegation of any overt act against the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has remained in custody since 18.01.2018.

Taking into consideration that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and that she has remained in custody since 18.01.2018, petitioner, namely, Deo Kumari Devi, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with Panki Police Station Case No.28 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No.594 of 2014.
