Prayer in the writ petition is for a direction upon the respondents to grant pension to the husband of the petitioner which would entitle her to receive family pension.

2. By filing a counter-affidavit dated 29.06.2018, the respondent-C.M.P.F has pleaded that on transmission of Rs. 2,93,356/- in C.M.P.F account which was the amount of contribution required to be deposited by the husband of the petitioner, a decision has been taken to grant pension and accordingly, P.P.O dated 28.06.2018 has been issued; monthly pension has been fixed at Rs. 1383/- per month and arrears of pension has been calculated to Rs. 3,45,287/- for the period between 15.04.2006 to 31.05.2018.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. Ordered accordingly.
