The petitioner is an accused for the offence punishable under sections 395/412 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. He has not been put on T.I. parade. The name of the petitioner has transpired from the confessional statement of the co-accused and after his arrest he has confessed the guilt. The similarly situated co-accused Raja Kumar Saw @ Raja Kumar Sao and Tribhuwan Kumar Gupta have been granted bail by this Court in B.A. No. 9421 of 2017 and one another co-accused, namely, Anil Munda has also been granted bail by this Court in B.A. No. 1568 of 2018.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, namely, Shankar Bhuiyan is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Ramgarh, in connection with S.T. No. 38 of 2018, arising out of Ramgarh P.S. Case No.299 of 2017, corresponding to G.R. No. 967 of 2017.
