Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in connection with Telco P.S. Case No. 34/2018 corresponding to G.R. No. 604/2018 in a case registered under Sections 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that it is a case of land dispute. Petitioner has been named in the FIR and motorcycle and four cartridges have been recovered from his possession. There is no injury on the person of the informant as it appears from the FIR itself. Petitioner is in custody since the first week of 2018.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering that there is no injury on the person of the informant, and there is land dispute between the parties, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Miss P. Bajpayee, Learned Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur in connection with Telco P.S. Case No. 34/2018 corresponding to G.R. No. 604/2018.
