Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in a case registered under Sections 147, 341, 323, 353, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that Afzal Ansari was arrested and these petitioners along with others have been alleged that they created a mob and have helped Afzal Ansari in fleeing away from police custody. Subsequently, Afzal Ansari was taken into custody. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner Nos.1, 2 and 3 are in custody since 19.04.2018 and petitioner No.4 is in custody since 13.04.2018.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Be that as it may, since Afzal Ansari has already been taken into custody and these petitioners are in custody since April, 2018, all the four petitioners, named above, directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Godda, in connection with Godda (M) P.S. Case No.90 of 2015, corresponding to G.R. Case No.306 of 2015, with a condition that they will remain present before the trial Court on each & every date, till conclusion of the trial, failing which, trial Court is directed to cancel bail bond of the petitioner.
