The petitioner is an accused for the offence punishable under sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 342, 504, 506, 302 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code and under section 17 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act.

From the F.I.R. it is apparent that the informant was assaulted by the butt of the gun by the miscreants, who were members of the extremists group. It is alleged that the petitioner directed the informant to prepare food but she refused on the ground of poverty. It is alleged that extremists group entered the house of the informant with fire arm and they assaulted with butt of the rifle.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is general allegation levelled against this petitioner and one similarly situated co-accused person has been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in B.A. No. 4828 of 2017 and one another co-accused, namely, Nandu Yadav has also been granted bail by this Court in B.A. No. 1426 of 2018. He submits that the assault is by the butt of the rifle.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, namely, Ajay Prasad Sao @ Ajay Prasad Sahu @ Raushan Gee @ Raushan is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned District & Additional Sessions Judge-VI, Garhwa, in connection with S.T. Case No. 139 of 2017, arising out of Ramkanda P.S. Case No. 30 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. No. 1946 of 2016.
