4/31.10.2018 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State, who opposes the prayer for bail.

The petitioner is an accused for allegedly committing offence punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prayer for bail of this petitioner was earlier rejected by this Court on 22.03.2018 after considering the statement of Chairiya Urain recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. Now, said Chairiya Urain has been examined as PW-3, wherein she has not whispered the name of this petitioner as an assailant. Further, after examination of PW-3, two other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid fact, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, petitioner namely, Rati Oraon @ Ratia Oraon is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional District & Sessions Judge- 3rd, Gumla in connection with S.T. No. 38 of 2018, arising out of Bharno P.S. Case No. 51 of 2017 [G.R. No. 989/2017], subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the court below on each and every date so fixed in the trial and if he fails to appear even on a single date, his bail bonds shall stand cancelled and steps for taking him into custody shall be taken by the trial court.
