The petitioner is an accused for the offence punishable under Section(s) 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with Baliapur P.S. Case No. 16/2002, corresponding to G.R. No. 651 of 2002, pending in the Court of learned Addl. & Session Judge-XI, Dhanbad.

From perusal of FIR as well as record, it appears that that deceased had taken the name of this petitioner and two others who assaulted him. The deceased died, while he was being taken to hospital.

In view of the aforesaid facts, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner, above named, is **rejected**.
