Heard learned counsel for the parties. Learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

The petitioner is an accused for allegedly committing an offence punishable under Sections 17 of the CLA Act and Section 13 of the UAP Act, 1967.

It is alleged that some miscreants pasted the posters of banned extremists organization and thereafter damaged some computers of old weigh bridge.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 7.9.2018 and charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. He submits that petitioner is not named in the FIR. He further submits that petitioner was also not put on TIP.

Considering the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted in this case and petitioner was not put on TIP, I am inclined to allow this application. Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramgarh in connection with Mandu Police Station Case No. 301 of 2016 (G.R. No. 1089 of 2016), subject to the condition that petitioner will appear and mark his attendance once in a month before the officer-in-charge of Mandu police Station (District Ramgarh), failing which the bail bond of the petitioner shall stand cancelled and the officer-in-charge of Mandu police station shall take all possible steps for his re-arrest.
