

2. 30.05.2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail to the petitioner in connection with Rayagada P.S. Case No.64 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. Case No.156 of 2018 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Rayagada for offences punishable under sections 120-B/420/379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner moved an application for bail before the learned Sessions Judge, Rayagada which was rejected on 02.05.2018.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 19.04.2018 and in the meantime, the investigation has made substantial progress and the fact that the offences are triable by Magistrate and after hearing the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/-(Rupees twenty thousand) with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further terms and conditions as the learned Court may deem just and proper.

The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
