Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Advocate.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition so as to prefer appeal under Section-9 of the Orissa Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act, 1972.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event the petitioner files an appeal within a period of two weeks hence along with certified copy of this order, the delay in filing the appeal shall be condoned and the appeal shall be heard on its own merit extending reasonable opportunity to the petitioner.

During pendency of the appeal no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner, if he has not been evicted in the meantime.

Urgent certified copy of the order shall be granted on proper application.
