The petitioner has filed this application seeking direction to the opposite parties to disburse the compensation amount as per his right, title and interest by making proper apportionment amongst the co-sharers.

M.K. Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the selfsame cause of action the petitioner has already preferred C.S. No.104 of 2018 before the learned Civil Judge, Sr. Division, Nayagarh, which is pending consideration.

In course of hearing, M.K. Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach the appropriate forum/authority for redressal of his grievances.

Prayer is granted.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
