Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking for a direction to opposite party no.2 to sanction the annual increment of the petitioner with effect from 01.07.2018, as there is no full-fledged Governing Body in the college as per Rule 25 of the Orissa Education (Establishment, Recognition and Management of Private Colleges) Rules, 1991, before his retirement from service i.e. 31.12.2018 so that the petitioner will be able to get pension and other retrial benefits after retirement from service in due course within a time to be stipulated by this Court.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-11, but no decision has yet been taken.

Considering the limited grievance of the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2 to take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-11 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.
