The case of the petitioner is that he was appointed as Peon on contingency basis in the year 1978 but he has not been extended the benefit of Kramonnati / Time Bound Promotion Pay-scale on the completion of 10/20 years and 12/24 years of service.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is covered by the judgment of this Court in the case of **Teju Lal Yadav Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh & Others** reported in **ILR (2009) MP 1326**.

When the matter is taken up today learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the petitioner has already submitted the representation dated 23/06/2018 before the respondent No.2 and the said representation has not been decided till now.

Learned counsel for the State submits that there is no objection in deciding the representation within a time bound period.

Having regard to the aforesaid, without adverting to the merits of the matter, the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the petitioner's pending representation dated 23/06/2018 in light of the
