The petitioner has filed the present contempt petition alleging non-compliance of the order dated 17/04/2018 passed in MCRC no. 28327/2017.

By the aforesaid order, the MCRC was disposed of with the direction to the respondent/s to submit status report positively within a period of 60 days. According to the petitioner, the respondent has not submitted any report.

There is no material in this contempt petition in respect of communication of this order to respondent no. 1. The petitioner has unnecessarily impleaded respondent no. 2 as contemnor in this petition, against whom, there is no direction in the order dated 17/04/2018. Even the petitioner has not brought this order to the knowledge of the concerned Magistrate. Present contempt petition is nothing, but misuse of process of law.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
