Learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that as the complainant has turned hostile before the trial Court, therefore, trial of criminal case no.274/2017 pending against them under Sections 294,323,342,498-A,506,34 of IPC is mere futile practice and the same be quashed.

No doubt the petitioners have been charge sheeted on the basis of the complaint made by daughter-in-law, who now has turned hostile, but looking to the other evidence collected during investigation, in my considered opinion, the charge sheet or the criminal prosecution of the petitioners cannot be quashed at this stage, therefore, the petition is dismissed and disposed of.
