Shri Sudeep Chatterjee, learned G.A. for the respondents/State.

Shri Soni, submits that petitioners' case is covered by the judgment of this court passed in **W.A. No.348/2008 (Usha Ranwat vs. State of MP)**. The respondents be directed to decide his claim by applying the principle of parity.

Shri Chatterjee, learned G.A. contends that if the petitioners prefer representation, it will be decided in accordance with law.

Considering the aforesaid, the petitioners are directed to submit a representation alongwith the judgment on which reliance is placed before the respondent No. 2 to 3. In turn, the said respondents are directed to decide the representation in the light of the judgment passed in **Usha Ranawat (Supra)** and if the petitioners are entitled to get the said benefit, benefits be extended in their favour within 90 days. If respondents decide otherwise, they shall pass reasoned and speaking order and communicate the same to the petitioners.

Petition is **disposed of** without expressing any view on the merits of the case.
