Petitioner is challenging the order dated 30.12.2016  
(Annexure P/4) passed by Sub Divisional Officer, Tehsil  
Teonthar District Rewa holding that the petitioner is not  
entitled to receive the compensation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that claim  
of the petitioner has been rejected only on the ground that  
after he has purchased the land his name has not been  
mutated in the revenue records.

In the considered opinion of this Court, this question can  
be gone into in a Civil Court on evidence and writ jurisdiction  
is not the appropriate forum for doing this exercise.  
Therefore, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the  
petitioner to file a civil suit for declaration of the title.

With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed  
of.
