This petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging that the respondent No.6 has been granted admission on the basis of false and fabricated documents produced by her relating to her being a permanent residence and domicile of M.P.

It is submitted that the petitioner has filed a complaint in this regard before the authorities of the Medical University which has been forwarded to the Director Medical Education but no action or decision thereon has been taken by the authorities. In the circumstances, it is prayed that the authorities be directed to take a decision on the petitioner's complaint.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of with a direction to the effect that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent authorities within fifteen days from today alongwith a copy of the order passed today and a copy of the petition, the concerned authority shall consider and decide the complaint filed by the petitioner expeditiously in accordance with law as far as possible preferably within a period of three months from today after giving necessary and due opportunity of hearing to the respondent No.6.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter and therefore, the respondent authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter take a decision on the complaint filed by the petitioner.

With the aforesaid direction, the petition filed by the petitioner stands **disposed of**.
