Applicant has filed this application for transfer of Hindu Marriage Case No. 144/2016 which is pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Chhindwara.

Transfer has been sought on the ground that the distance from Chhindwara to Jabalpur is about 250 kms. and there is no one in the family to accompany her on each date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the Family Court has recorded the statement of non-applicant and he further submits that the Family Court may be directed to decide the case within a period of one month as the same is pending since 2016.

In view of the aforesaid, I do not find any reason to transfer the case from Chhindwara to Jabalpur at this stage, when the evidence of the respondent has already been recorded.

Looking to the grounds raised in the application, the Family Court is directed to decide the matter as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months.

The respondent is directed to pay the travelling expenses and other expenses to the applicant.

With the aforesaid, the application stands disposed of.
