THIS CRIMINAL PETITION IS FILED UNDER SECTION 482 CR.P.C PRAYING TO QUASH THE ENTIRE PROCEEDINGS IN S.C.NO.1417/2018 (CR.NO.277/2014) PENDING ON THE FILE OF THE LXXI ADDITIONAL CITY CIVIL AND SESSIONS JUDGE, BENGALURU (CCH-72) FILED BY THE UPPARPET POLICE STATION/CCB(W AND N) SQUAD, FOR THE ALLEGED OFFENCES P/U/Ss.188, 370A, 370(3), 294 R/W. 109 OF IPC.

THIS PETITION COMING ON FOR ADMISSION THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

**ORDER**

Heard Shri Nagaiah, learned advocate for the petitioners and Shri K.P. Yoganna, learned HCGP for the State.

2. Learned advocate for the petitioners submits that all petitioners are accused in the proceedings before the Trial Court for the offences punishable under Sections 188, 370A, 370(3), 294 r/w. 109 of IPC in Crime No.277/2014 registered in Upparpet Police Station. He further submits that petitioners are customers who had visited the Bar and Restaurant run in the name and style as 'Casino Royale Bar and Restaurant'. The proceedings against two other similarly situated co-accused who are also customers, have been quashed by this Court in CrI.P.No.3026/2017 (D.D. on 11.12.2017). Hence, he prays that proceedings against the petitioners herein also may be quashed.

3. Learned HCGP, in his usual fairness, does not dispute the facts narrated by the learned advocate for the petitioners.

4. It is recorded in Crl.P.No.3026/2017 that the petitioners therein were also customers. In the circumstances, following the said decision, this petition is allowed. The proceedings in S.C.No.1417/2018 pending on the file of the LXXI Additional City Civil and Sessions Judge, Bengaluru (CCH-72) are quashed *qua* the petitioners.

5. In view of disposal of the petition, I.A.No.1/2018 does not survive for consideration and the same is also disposed of.

Petition is accordingly ***disposed of***. No costs.
