THIS WRIT PETITION (CIVIL) HAVING COME UP FOR ADMISSION ON 30.11.2018, THE COURT ON THE SAME DAY DELIVERED THE FOLLOWING:

# JUDGMENT

The petitioner, a contract carriage operator and registered owner of a bus, assails the Exts.P9 and P10 memos demanding arrears of motor vehicle tax. The petitioner has filed the writ petition seeking the following reliefs:

- i) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ of order commanding the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to re-determine the tax liability of vehicle No.KL-02V-8643 taking note of the garaging of the vehicle as evidenced by Exhibit.P5 and P7 reports and taking note of the expiry of permit and fitness period of the vehicle for the period commencing from 01.07.2014 onwards.
- ii) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or order restraining from the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent from initiating any recovery steps pursuant to Exhibit.P9 and P10 demand notices pending consideration of the re-determination of tax liability on account of the mistakes committed in the said demand notices."
- 2. The Department has joined the issue by filing a counter affidavit. It has set out the grounds justifying the Exts.P9 and P10. In this context, the Government Pleader has also pointed out that the petitioner has an efficacious appellate remedy against the Exts.P9 and P10 memos.

3. In response, the petitioner's counsel draws my attention to the corrections in the Exts.P9 and P10. According to him, those corrections have not been authenticated. If the authorities vouch for those corrections, then the petitioner can be sure of the demand against him. He further submits that the demanded tax quantified, the petitioner can as well exhaust his appellate remedies. The Government Pleader in turn submits, on instructions, that the corrected amounts mentioned in Exts.P9 and P10 are the accurate ones and there can be no dispute about it.

Under these circumstances, without adverting to the merits, I dispose of the Writ Petition, holding that the petitioner can avail himself the appellate remedy under Section 23 of the Kerala Motor Vehicle Taxation Act. As the petitioner has bonafide pursued this Writ Petition, if he files an appeal in two weeks, the appellate authority will exclude the period the petitioner spent before this Court from the limitation period.
