PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER: The Court Made the following order:-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 363, 307, 379 of I.P.C. and Section 21 (4) of MMDR Act in Crime No.110 of 2018 and seeks anticipatory bail.

- 2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent.
- 3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs. 5000/- to the credit of Crime No. 110 of 2018 before the concerned Judicial Magistrate. It is open to the *de facto* complainant to withdraw the same.
- 4. Considering the facts of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Tirunelveli and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties https://hcservices.ecourts.gov.in/hcservices/each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear

before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
