2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent.

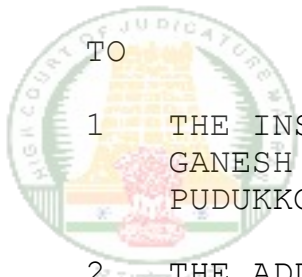
3.It is a case of abduction for ransom. The allegations are very serious and grave in nature. Hence, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
