Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 10.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. Counsel for the petitioners states that actually the date of birth of the petitioner No. 1 is 10.1.1997 and he has filed an affidavit in this regard and for petitioner No.2 a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) has been placed on record depicting her year of birth as 1995. They have also moved a representation before the Sr.

Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertng to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
