Petitioners Supriya and Harpreet Kumar have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1. A copy of Aadhar Card of petitioner No.2 has been annexed with petition indicating his age as 29 years. Though no document to establish the date of birth of petitioner No.1 has been annexed with the petition but an affidavit of petitioner No.1 has been annexed as Annexure P-1 wherein it has been deposed that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 17.7.1999 as has been recorded in her Aadhar Card. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in fact all the certificates and testimonials of petitioner No.1 are lying at her parental home and she does not have any access to the same as a result of which her birth certificate/Aadhar Card could not be annexed with the petition.

The petitioners apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 seek issuance of appropriate directions.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar to look

into the representation dated 29.6.2018 (Annexure P-4) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.
